Chili in Cheapside Park Chili Cook-Off

Rules

When: Sunday, April 11

Time: Check-In: 2:30pm – 3:00pm, Judging: 3:00 pm

1. This chili cook-off is open to DLC member restaurants with a current Food Handlers Permit issued by the Fayette County Health Department. This permit must be onsite during the event.
2. The prepared chili MUST BE COVERED with a tent, umbrella, ect. in accordance with the Fayette County Health Department regulations
3. All chili must be prepared in restaurants and taken to Cheapside Park. There will be no time for cooking once the contest has begun; however, time will be given to prepare cups to present to the judges.
4. Each team must make at least three gallons of chili to be judged and then sold to the public. You are welcome to make any variety of chili: beef, chicken, vegetarian, ANYTHING! There will be no category distinction for varieties of chili.
5. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils; however, standard sized cups will be provided for the public to sample the chili.
6. There will be no electricity available to any contestant.
7. Each entry will need to provide their own table and chairs.
8. Only one cup of chili per judge can be submitted for judging.
9. Each contestant will be assigned a number and be given judging cups. Each contestant should verify that the number on the bottom of their cup is the same as their assigned contestant number. Each contestant is responsible to deliver their cup, which must be filled to the bottom of the cup's rim, to the judging area at the official time for judging.
10. Judges will be told they should vote for the chili they like best based on the following considerations: good flavor, texture, consistency, blend of spices, aroma, and color.
